

TEAM VISION

TEAM ROLE

TEAM RESPONSIBILITIES

 Check Planning Center Online for weekly reminders and to preview changes to Weekend Service plans. Also, check the Sojourn City Church Worship & Media Facebook group for links to new songs, announcements, etc.

- Serve when scheduled and contact the Worship Leader when you need a replacement, preferably two weeks ahead. Utilize the Blockout feature in Planning Center for days you plan to be absent.
- Attend practices/rehearsals.
- Preparation: Listen and know planned songs before arriving at practice. The team will only be as musically proficient as the individuals that make it up, and an excellent team will attract others who are excellent.
- Be on time.
- Membership on the team is a position of Christian leadership. Let us be witnesses and lead others to the truth, not be a stumbling block to anyone. You are a representation of Christ and this church wherever you go- let us be such good representatives that unbeliever's see and praise God. (1 Peter 2:12)
- Engage in personal worship on and off the stage- lead by example and be prepared in prayer.
- Ministry Appropriateness. Dress in a manner that honors Christ. Here are a few helpful guidelines. Please don't put the worship pastor in the awkward position of asking you to change. If in doubt, don't wear it.
 - Men:
 - Bottoms: No very tight or form fitting pants
 - Shirts: No holes/rips/tears
 - Shoes: No flip-flops
 - Women:
 - Bottoms: Jeans/Slacks/Capri
 - Leggings: Paired with a dress/shirt coming to mid-thigh or longer
 - Shirts: Comfortable yet appropriate; not too tight or revealing and not rise above the waistline
 - Shoes: Shoes, sandals, or boots that allow you to move around freely
- Pay attention to your personal health (physical, emotional, mental, and spiritual). If at any time you feel uncomfortable or frustrated please talk to the worship pastor or the senior pastor. We are a team- we care about every person's full wellbeing.
